This project was submitted as a renewal project application during the Local Competition. The project's final score consisted of 65% performance score and 35% local score in accordance with the local FY24 Review, Scoring, and Ranking Policy. This project's final score of 62.82 was the lowest score amongst all new and renewal applicants, which resulted in the project being rejected. The applicant was notified of this result on October 11, 2024.

3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)

Following the procedures outlined in the local FY24 Reallocation and Deobligation Policy, the project applicant submitted a transition grant request letter to the CoC Board on July 3, 2024, indicating its intent to submit a transition grant application for this project during the FY24 CoC NOFO Local Competition for the purposes of creating a scattered-site PSH project dedicated to youth and young adults experiencing chronic homelessness. The letter outlined the reasonings behind this request (e.g., the need for more flexible and longer-term programming for youth with complex needs) and how current project participants will be supported during the transition process (e.g., transferring youth to other non-CoC funded RRH projects). The project applicant was notified of the CoC's Board's pre-approval of the applicant's intent to transition on August 14, 2024. The project was officially notified of its acceptance and ranking into the FY24 Priority Listing as a new transition project on October 11, 2024.
